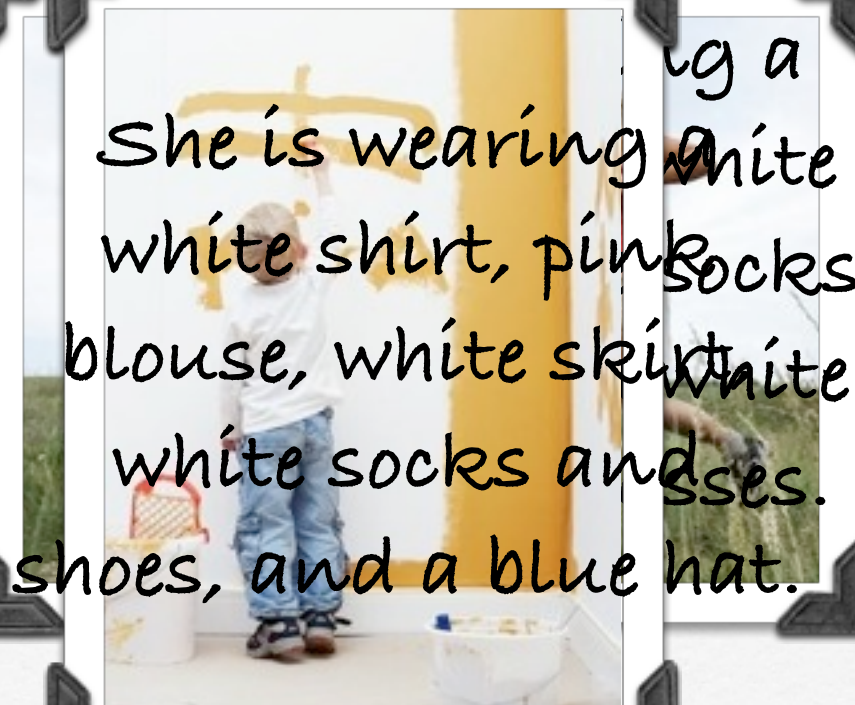
Mais vocabulário

Say what the person is wearing and what color the clothes are./Disse o que a pessoa está vestindo e qual cor é a roupa.

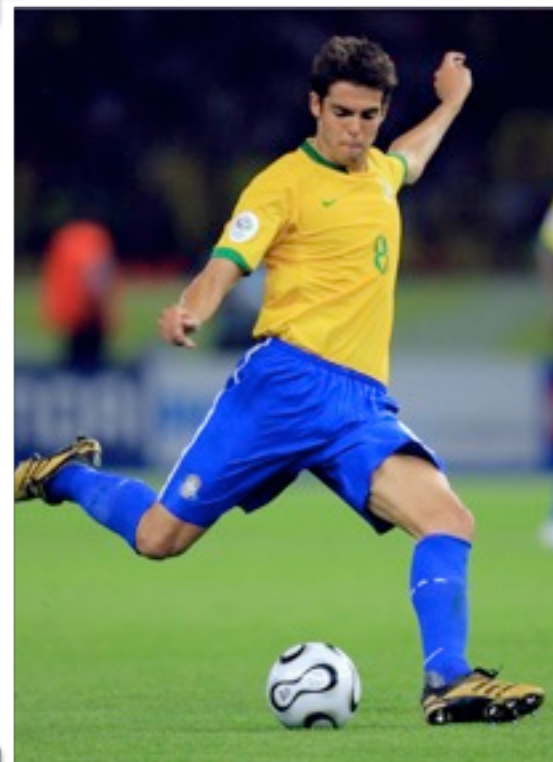


She is wearing a white shirt, pink socks, white blouse, white skirt, white socks and shoes, and a blue hat.



Gramatica: forma passiva:

- In the passive form, the subject receives the action of the verb.
- Form the passive by adding "-ado" to the stem of the verb:
eg. Pintado 'painted', comido 'eaten', dividido 'divided'
- The passive uses the present form of estar:
Eg. The verb was used./O verbo foi usado.
The food is prepared./A comida está preparada.
They will be killed./Eles serão matados.

Gramática: Imperativo



- The imperative is easy: -
ar verbs end with -e, and
-er/-ir verbs end with -a.
eg. Mude a sua roupa!
'Change your clothes!'
Coma a sua comida!
'Eat your food!'

- With "ir", the imperative
is the conjugated form
of the verb.
eg. Vá para escola! 'Go
to school!'
